## Dear colleagues and friends,

Welcome to the Summer school “*Migration – Trauma in Transition: Exploring sociotraumatic roots of dealing with refugees*” that is taking place from 21<sup>st</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> September 2018, at the Faculty of Philosophy in Belgrade. The Summer school is organized as part of the *East-West-Dialogue project* that connects German universities with universities from the Western Balkans and is funded by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD). Summer school participants are professors, researchers, experts/practitioners and advanced students from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Germany, Greece, Serbia and Turkey.

### The program of the Summer school includes:

- *Keynote lectures*, connecting migration to social trauma and providing input to the dialogue between participants
- *Masters’ level course on social trauma (CST)* involving also the discussion of refugee issues and encompassing the perspective of clinical, developmental, general and social psychology, ethics and research methodology
- *Expert discussion groups* in which refugee experts/practitioners and social trauma researchers will discuss issues regarding the three current fields of intersection between Migration and Social Trauma: *integration* of refugees into the host communities, their *education* (integration of refugee children into the school system) and *mental health* of refugees
- *Fishbowl plenary sessions* in which the experts will share the results of the discussion groups to the summer school students so they could be validated and further discussed
- Film screening and analysis, student research supervisions and reflection groups, panel discussion and book presentation, educational social activity for students
